**Overview:** The Bone Marrow Donor Programme (BMDP) is a non-profit organisation responsible for building and managing Singapore's only register of volunteer donors who are willing to donate their bone marrow to save the lives of patients with leukaemia and other blood diseases and who need a transplant to survive. The BMDP also provides a service to the hospitals to find a matching donor for their patients. So far almost 500 patients have been given a chance of survival through the work of the BMDP and the need grows every year as transplants become a routine treatment for these most common forms of cancer. The cost of adding each new donor onto the register is \$200.00 to pay for the laboratory fees and equipment.
