Join the 10-Swab Challenge Brought to you by the A.C.T

The 10-Swab Challenge is a pilot initiative led by the newly formed Ambassadors Core Team, A.C.T for short. They are a group of driven and committed individuals working hand in hand with the BMDP to lead the ambassador programme. They are committed to put their passion into ACTion and together, they will be leading the Ambassadors Programme.



First up, A.C.T has a challenge for you! Join the 10-swab challenge where you can register your friends online! The game plan is simple – get at least 10 people to request for swab kit online with your Ambassador unique ID. They will then receive the swab kit in the mail where they will fill up the registration form and swab their cheek from home. Once completed, they will mail the kit back in the business reply envelope provided. You will receive regular updates on the number of swabs returned from donors affiliated to you. This challenge will last three months.

Top 3 Questions You've Been Asking

Many of you have been asking us questions pertaining to donor recruitment. Here is a compilation of the top 3 questions that we have been asked.

1. How do I assess if someone is eligible?

2. How to explain why joining the BMDP Register is important?

We are the only register in Singapore providing a volunteer matching donor to patients with blood diseases such as leukaemia and lymphoma in need of a transplant. BMDP is often, the only avenue left to find a donor match after the patient's family. Expanding our database of potential marrow donors is crucial in increasing the chance of finding a matching donor for these patients.

3. Can my stem cells regenerate after donation? Yes, bone marrow donation requires 5% of your stem cells and they will regenerate within 4-6 weeks.
