

Pre-Transplant Phase

SCHEME 1

Verification Typing (VT) Subsidy

Singaporean and Permanent Resident (PR) are eligible for a pre-approved subsidy on the cost of one donor VT. Patients in subsidised ward classes will receive full subsidy for BMDP donor VT costs. The subsidy rates for International donor VT costs are applicable based on ward classes.

SCHEME 2

Hematopoietic Progenitor Cell (HPC) Procurement Subsidy

The HPC Procurement Subsidy helps to cover the costs involved in procuring peripheral blood stem cells (PBSC) or bone marrow (BM). Patients in subsidised ward classes will receive full subsidy for BMDP donor procurement costs.

The tiered subsidies for international donor procurement are applicable based on ward classes, including patients undergoing Related Donor transplant which subsidises the donor bills.

- **Tier 1:** One lump sum subsidy to offset the HPC procurement cost.
- **Tier 2:** Subsidizes the total HPC product cost according to Ward Classes.
- **Tier 3:** Covers up to 100% of HPC product cost for needy patients in Ward Classes B2 & C, subject to a recommendation by an accredited Medical Social Worker (MSW) and BMDP's approval.

SCHEME 3

Transplant-Related Cost Subsidy

The Transplant-Related Cost Subsidy fund supports costs associated with Matched Unrelated Donor (MUD) and Related Donor transplants. This financial support hopes to alleviate the patients' hospital expenses related to the transplant.

Transplant-Related Cost Subsidy	S\$50,000	• BMDP will provide the funds to cover the transplant-related costs for patients up to S\$50,000 of the final hospital bill size.* • For Related Donor transplants, the stem cell procurement will be covered under Scheme 2.

SCHEME 4

Post-Transplant Allowance

The Post-Transplant Allowance helps to alleviate the post-transplant expenses to support patients through the expenditures after transplant.

Post-Transplant Allowance	S\$500 per month for a maximum of 12 months	• Patients with Unrelated or Related Donor transplants are eligible. • BMDP will fund the allowance in 2 tranches, each covering a 6-month period. • The Medical Social Worker (MSW) is required to submit an application for each tranche.*

Who may qualify?

- Singaporean and Permanent Resident
- Non-citizen Spouse and Child of Singaporean and Permanent Resident

***Note:**

- Funding application is subjected to recommendation put up by MSW and BMDP's approval.
- BMDP will have the discretion in the administration of funds/subsidies.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Who is eligible for the subsidy schemes?

Singaporean and Permanent Resident (PR) are eligible for Schemes 1-4. Non-citizen spouse and child of Singapore and PR are only eligible for Scheme 2. Qualifying subsidies and rates are applicable based on ward classes.

How can I apply for the subsidy schemes?

For patients applying for Schemes 1 & 2, your medical team will send your application to BMDP on your behalf. Patients who wish to apply for Schemes 3 & 4 may do so through a recommendation by an accredited Medical Social Worker (MSW).

How long does it take to know the outcome of my applications?

For Schemes 1 & 2, the various subsidy rates will apply to qualifying patients automatically. For Schemes 2, 3 & 4, the outcome may take about 3 working days.

Who is funding the subsidy schemes?

The funding comes from the financial donations of members of the public and corporate partners of the BMDP.

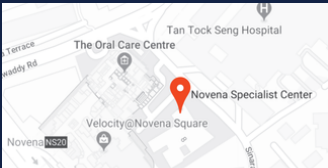
